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1 Corinthians 13:13 And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.

Faith is preached, love is preached, but when did you last hear a sermon on hope. Hope is an interesting word which in a biblical sense does not mean what most think this word means. The word hope in the 1Cor13:13 is from the Greek word elpis, It has the meaning of something that is absolutely certain but as yet is still future, a well grounded expectation. While faith is present hope is certain but future. The word hope appears eleven times in the book of Romans.

*Romans 5:2 By whom also we have hopes by faith into this ~~glory whereof we stand~~ glory whereof we stand, and rejoice
3 And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience
4 And patience, experience ~~hope~~ experience,
5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love*

2 Peter 3:11 Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be
